

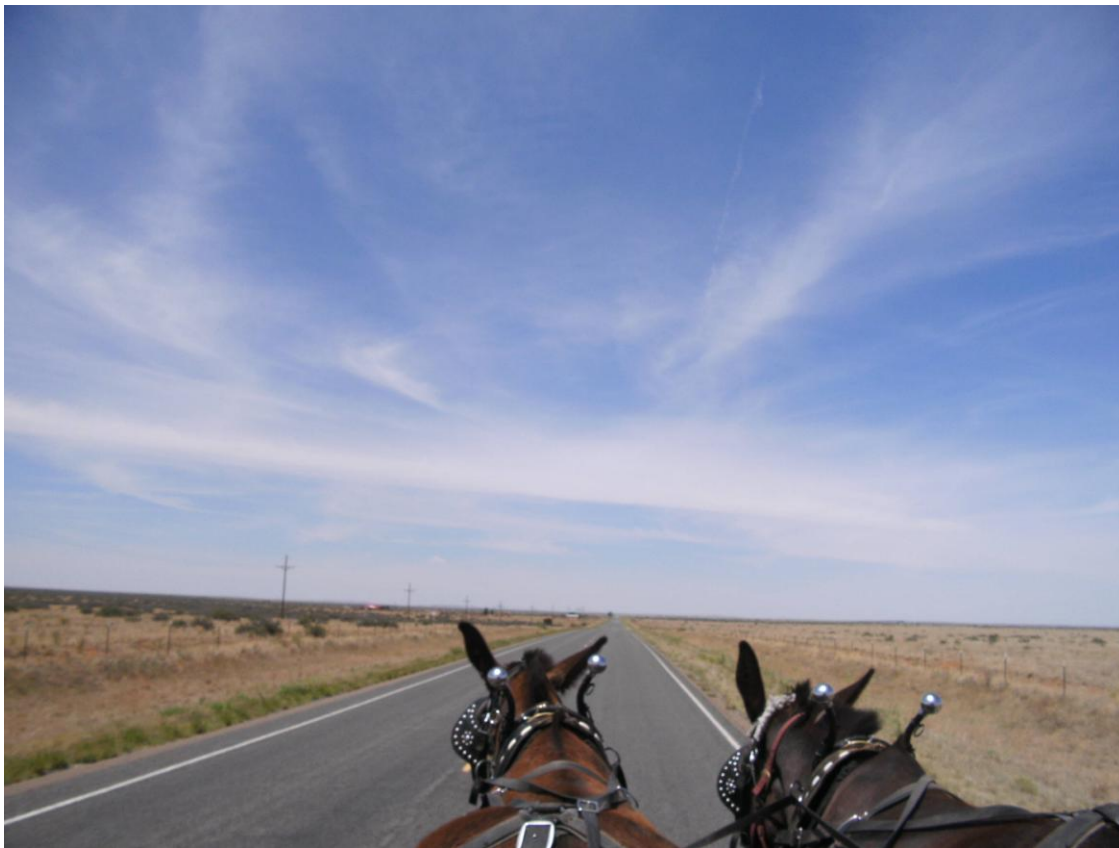
John's Journey - Day 65
